- ✓ "living word" idioms / proverbs representing the uniqueness of the linguistic heritage of the participant's homeland;
- ✓ traditional national costume:
- ✓ other objects of local tangible or intangible cultural heritage.

The participant of the Competition must provide the work (or its description)

in two languages.

One of the languages of the work must be the official language of the

participant's native country. The second language should be selected from the

official languages of the United Nations (Arabic, Chinese, English, French,

Russian and Spanish) and must be a foreign language for the participant.

Only original works are accepted for the Competition.

Contest winners will be invited to join the World Languages Festival

program, scheduled to be held at the Library for Foreign Literature in Moscow

during August 2024, spanning three days. The Library for Foreign Literature will

cover the accommodation and cultural program expenses for the contest winners.

After the conclusion of the contest, participants will receive certificates, and

winners will be presented with diplomas and prizes.
